

ORDINANCE NO. 54
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING DOGS IN EASTWOOD PARK

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TAMALPAIS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DOES ORDAIN PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE §61621.5 AS FOLLOWS:

DIVISION I. AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING DOG CONTROL IN EASTWOOD PARK

Section 1. Dog Control By Responsible Person.

It is unlawful for the owner or person having control of any dog to allow or permit such dog to be in Eastwood Park except on a leash or under the immediate control and direction of a responsible person.

Section 2. No Dog Permitted in Area of Play Structures.

No dog shall be permitted under any circumstances Eastwood Park within the area demarcated by the low concrete wall within which are located play structures and sand.

Section 3. Penalty.

Any person violating the provisions herein and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first offense, one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the second offense, and two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for any subsequent offense.

DIVISION II. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The District hereby declares that it would have adopted the ordinance, and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid.

DIVISION III. EFFECTIVE DATE

Upon adoption of this ordinance, it shall be entered in full in the minutes of the Tamalpais Community Services District Board, be posted within fifteen (15) days after passage, in three (3) public places within the District, there being no newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the District, and shall take effect thirty (30) days after passage.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors at the Tamalpais Community Services District, held on April 9, 1991.


