

ORDINANCE No 76

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF SEWER  
SERVICE CHARGES, DELINQUENT SEWER SERVICE CHARGES  
AND GARBAGE SERVICE CHARGES

TAMALPAIS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

The District Board of the Tamalpais Community Services District, County of Marin, California, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Tamalpais Community Services District, County of Marin, California, does hereby elect, pursuant to Sections 5473 and 5473.1 of the Health and Safety Code and Section 61621 of the Government Code of the State of California, to have certain charges for services and facilities, collected on the tax roll of the County of Marin, State of California, in the manner provided pursuant to Sections 5471 of the Health and Safety Code and Sections 54739 and 61621 of the Government Code of the State of California.

Section 2. Tuesday, the 26th day of July, 2005, at the hour of 7:00 p.m., at the regular meeting place of said Board, Tamalpais Community Services District, 305 Bell Lane, Mill Valley, California, is fixed as the time and place for hearing by this District, pursuant to law, and the Secretary shall publish notice of said hearing and of the filing of said report, once a week for two successive weeks prior to the date set for said hearing in the Independent Journal, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published with the County, there being no newspaper of general circulation printed and published within the District.

Section 3. Rate Schedule. Sewer service charges are hereby prescribed in accordance with the following schedules of charges:

SCHEDULE OF CHARGES

- A. Classification of Premises for Sewer Service within the Limits of the Tamalpais Community Services District Area: Single family dwelling unit (1 EDU). All other structures, or portions thereof used for purposes other than as single family dwelling units, shall be assigned a number of EDU's as determined by the District, based upon (1) water meter readings and/or use of water from non-metered sources. (2) Visual inspection to determine the relative extent to which water may be used for purposes which do not produce discharge into the District's facilities, (3) the chemical and/or other composition of the wastewater produced, (4) the peaking and the ebbing cycle of the wastewaters flows, and (5) any requirements imposed by the federal or state governments agencies thereof. For each EDU so assigned, the annual sewer service charge shall be per one EDU: \$710.00 per one EDU. Said increase shall be phased in over a three year period. In the first year following adoption of the rate increase (i.e. for fiscal year July 1, 2005 - June 30, 2006), the rate shall rise from \$301 per one EDU per year (the rate prior to this rate increase) to \$421.00 per one EDU per year. In the second year following adoption (i.e. for fiscal year July 1, 2006 - June 30, 2007), the rate shall rise to \$573.00 per one EDU per year. In the third year following adoption (i.e. for fiscal year July 1, 2007 - June 30, 2008) and thereafter, the rate shall rise to \$710.00 per one EDU per year.
- B. Classification of premises for refuse service charges within the limits of the Tamalpais Community Services District Area: Single-family dwelling unit (1 EDU). Commercial entities as defined by for profit ventures operating within the District will be classified (1 CE.) Each E.D.U. or C.E. shall pay for their use of debris and recycling services. Any dwelling unit or commercial entity desiring to decline service may do so. If an E.D.U. or C.E. of the District opts to decline service, then the residents or owner of that unit or commercial entity shall maintain their own service according to health and safety code standards. Such option shall not enable that party to employ an alternate private refuse collection agency to provide refuse service within the District.

Annual refuse charges shall be as follows for once per week pick-up service (unchanged from prior years):

Per Single Family Dwelling (E.D.U.)

1. One 32 Gal. Can      \$ 228.00
2. Two 32 Gal Cans     \$ 401.00
3. Three 32 Gal Cans   \$ 573.00
4. Each Additional Can \$ 172.00
5. Green can and recycling services are included on the schedule to be determined by the District for each E.D.U. receiving refuse service. As a stand-alone service the fee shall be \$35 for one green can and \$50.00 for recycling for weekly service.

Additional elective onetime services: (unchanged from prior years)

1. Bin rental for a period of one week with one dump: \$40.00  
Extra dump fee: \$30.00
2. Loose debris pick-up fee: \$40.00 per cu. yd.


Per Commercial Establishment (C.E.) (unchanged from prior years)

1. One 32 Gal. Can \$ 333.00
2. Two 32 Gal. Cans \$ 507.00
3. Three 32 Gal. Cans \$ 680.00
4. Each Additional Can \$ 275.00
5. Per 1.44 cu. yd. Bin \$ 1673.00

For pick up more than once the above rate is multiplied times the following factors: (unchanged from prior years)

2x = 1.8, 3x = 2.3, 4x = 2.8. 5x = 3.3.

Section 4. Upon adoption, this Ordinance shall be entered in the Minutes of the District Board and shall be posted for one week in three public places in the District, and shall take effect upon the conclusion of the hearing herein fixed to be held.
