

# **Don't Flush That!!**

**Swiffer wipes, sanitary wipes, baby wipes and disinfectant wipes have become increasingly popular – however they, as well as paper towels, tissues, feminine products, Q-tips, etc, are not flushable and should never be flushed down your toilet as they can clog your sewer line. Sanitation districts have long tried to educate customers that products marketed as “flushable” or “disposable” don't degrade easily and urge them never to flush anything down the toilet except the 3 p's...pee, poop and (toilet) paper!**
